



## Is Your Hand Sanitizer Safe?

### *Some Are Not Safe For Use*

The FDA has found an increasing amount of hand sanitizers that are labeled to contain ethyl alcohol, or ethanol, but have tested positive for methanol, or wood alcohol. If methanol is absorbed through the skin, it can cause hospitalizations, or death if ingested. In addition, they have found some hand sanitizers with low levels of ethyl alcohol or isopropanol; which are the active ingredients. The FDA list an import alert on a number of hand sanitizers containing methanol or are subpotent to stop the products from entering the U.S.:

- Blumen product
- Modesa Instant Hand Sanitizer Moisturizers and Vitamin E
- Hello Kitty by Sanrio Hand Sanitizer
- Assured Aloe

These products are commonly found in stores such as Walmart, Costco and other national chains. Keep your loved ones and yourself safe by being aware of and checking for these impacted products before you purchase. Have a discussion with them and show them how to check for recalled products.
