

## REQUIRED FOR ALL VISITORS

- A well-fitting medical grade mask over your nose and mouth at all times
- Additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) per hospital policy
- Maintain 6 feet physical distancing from health care workers and other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of your group

**Failure to comply with visitor guidelines or code of conduct may result in being denied future visitation**

### HOSPITAL VISITORS

- Visitors must be free of COVID-19 or other virus or flu symptoms
- Visitors must be 14 years of age or older
- Visiting hours may be limited based on a patient's clinical needs
- Adult inpatients are permitted two (2) visitors at a time
- Visitors for patients with special circumstances or clinical needs will be determined by the physician and nursing leadership

### EMERGENCY ROOM VISITORS

- Adult patients will be allowed **one (1)** designated visitor to join them
- Visitors for patients with special circumstances or clinical needs will be determined by the physician and nursing leadership
- Infants and pediatric patients will be allowed **one (1)** visitor to join them
  - Parents/Guardians will be able to substitute with only **one (1)** visitor at a time

### PEDIATRIC VISITORS

- Open visitation twenty-four (24) hours a day for parents or parent substitute only
- Visitors and siblings (14 years of age, and older) will observe the general visiting hours
- Sleeping accommodation for one (1) parent can be provided with prior arrangements

### LABOR & DELIVERY VISITORS

- Open visitation twenty-four (24) hours a day for the father of the newborn or the designated coach.
- Two (2) designated persons may be present during labor and delivery.
- With approval of the patient's delivering physician, up to four (4) may be permitted.
- Four (4) visitors at one time are permitted in the postpartum rooms.
- Siblings of the newborn may visit when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Visitation may be limited by the new parents at this time so they can spend the first hour of their baby's life uninterrupted

#### **Scheduled or Unscheduled C-section support guidelines:**

- For C-section procedures, the father/designated coach is allowed to be present for the C-section.
