With the opening of the ICU on October 2, 2023, 911 EMS transports to Adventist Health White Memorial Montebello have resumed. The Emergency Department is open to walk-ins, basic life support transports, and acute life support transports. The ICU is staffed by fully trained and experienced ICU nurses. Dr. Stephen Chen, a Critical Care Medicine Specialist, is the medical director of the ICU. Physician care for patients is provided at all times in our ICU.
